Printer and Driver Install:


- Follow the "Start Here" instructions included with the printer
- Once you get to step "5 Install software" go here to download the latest driver: http://www.epson.com/cgi-bin/Store/support/SupportIndex.jsp
- Search for "Artisan 1430" then, click the link then, click "Downloads & Drivers"
- Download the driver combo package and open the image
- Double click the Epson.app to run the installer
- During the installer you will setup either Wi-Fi or USB connection to the printer
- Load paper and print a test page to verify connection and then complete installer

Turn off High Speed Printing:

Once the printer is installed, Open System Preferences then, click printers



• Find the installed Epson Artisan 1430 and select it then, click Options & Supplies



• Select the Options tab then, set "High Speed Printing:" to off then, click OK



Printing From Illustrator on Mac:

Disclaimer: Printing from Illustrator on Mac to the Epson Artisan 1430 can produce

poor results.


Epson Driver Reference: Driver version: 9.31 Release date: 10/29/13 Filename: epson15637.dmg **Problem**: Printing from Illustrator on Mac produces jagged edge prints even with vector graphics. This is due to the lack of Postscript driver, which in Illustrator forces a bitmap output.

Workaround: In Illustrator, save as PDF. Then, open the PDF file in Adobe Acrobat or Reader and print from there.


The following steps demonstrate printing from Acrobat with the optimal Epson driver settings for using Rayzist Inkjet Film.

 In the print window of Adobe Acrobat or Reader, click the button "Printer" to access the advanced printer settings



A warning may appear, if so click yes to continue

• Find the dropdown set to Layout and change it to "Print Settings" then, set the following:



Media Type: Ultra Premium Photo Paper Luster

Print Quality: Photo RPM (highest)


Grayscale: checked




- Now Switch to the setting dropdown "Color Options"
- Expand Advanced Settings and drag the Brightness slider left to the max (-25)




• Once you have these settings correct, click the Presets dropdown and click "Save Current Settings as Preset..."



Name the preset and click OK



• Now click Print to commit those settings
